You'll be aware that Y6 have their national SATs week approaching. The dates of the test administrations are as follows:

Test	Date
English: Grammar, punctuation and spelling test Paper 1: short answer questions (45 minutes) Paper 2: spelling (15 minutes)	Monday 13 <sup>th</sup> May
English: Reading test Paper 1: reading comprehension (60 minutes)	Tuesday 14 <sup>th</sup> May
Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic (30 minutes) Paper 2: reasoning (40 minutes)	Wednesday 15 <sup>th</sup> May
Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning (40 minutes)	Thursday 16 <sup>th</sup> May

## **Breakfast Club**

During SATs week, we have always offered our Y6 children a FREE breakfast club each morning. This has proven to be an incredibly important and valuable opportunity to bring all the children together for some fun, games, activities and lovely food to start each day. Children need to arrive at school for 8am each morning during SATs week. Year 6 staff will be here to meet and greet the children and ensure that every child has a calm, positive and relaxed start to the day. Children are permitted to bring their mobile phones to breakfast club, and they will then be stored in the class box until the end of the school day.
