Superb attainment results against the new more rigorous standards in SATS at St Mary's in the latest published tests. The 'average scaled scores' shown indicate in short that we are above both Cheshire West and national scores in every area, with above average attainment and progress. We had a rise in attainment overall, which has kept us at or above national for 4 years in a row – this year, well above national attainment in every test area. Changes in personnel, an exciting new School Development Plan and embedding of many strategies over time (such as the Cheshire Maths Reasoning Project) have really paid dividends.

You will notice also that the number of children working at 'greater depth' standard (that is, at the higher level) is well above national too, in the tests.

We are working hard in our action plan to ensure that writing scores rise to the same standard as other scores; and we know that it is essential for more children to attain higher standards in writing across the school. Our handwriting policy, our quality scheme called 'Pathways to

Writing', a rigorous monitoring schedule, and our opportunities to write, embedded across our carefully planned curriculum, are all examples of our striving for the highest standards.

YEAR 1 PHONICS SCREENING CHECK – LATEST RESULTS.

At the end of the first year of the national curriculum (Year 1), pupils are given a national external screening assessment, to see if they know their phonics (i.e. the sounds and letters that make up the English language.)

Every year, the school has been above or well above the national average with our highest score ever, in the latest tests, as you can see below.
